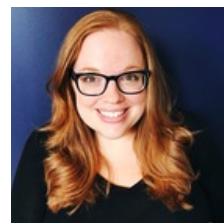

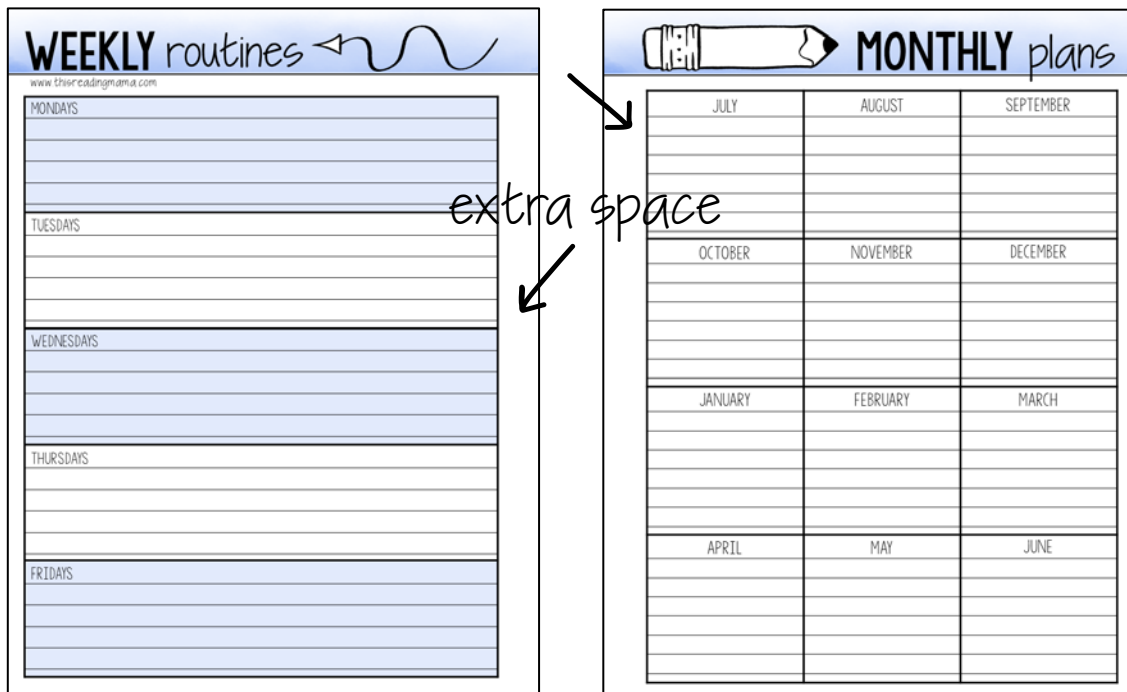

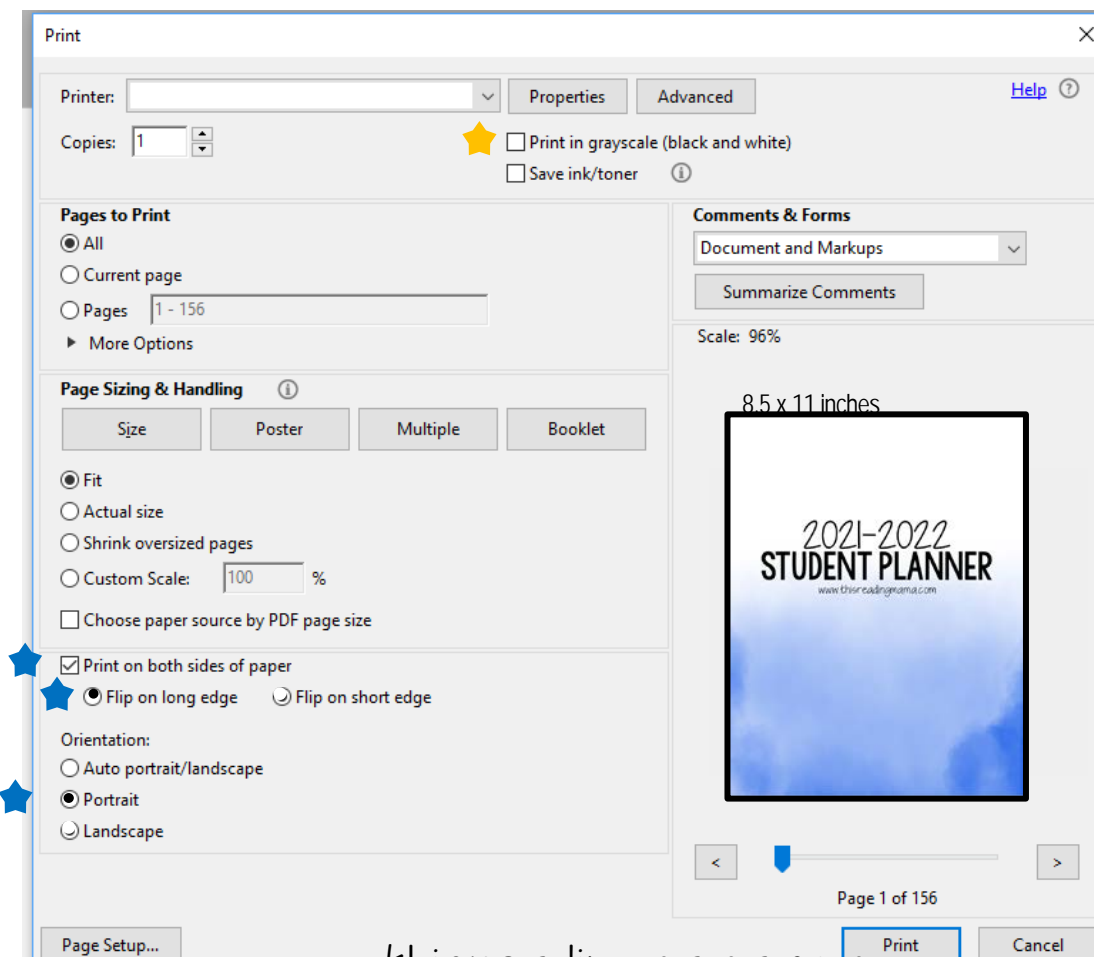
3 OPTIONS FOR PRINTING

1- Print the planner at a print & copy shop and get it spiral-bound. Some print shops require a permission letter, so you may need to print and take along the letter on page 3 of this file. Be sure to specify if you want the color planner or black/white planner.

2. Print the pages front to back from home.

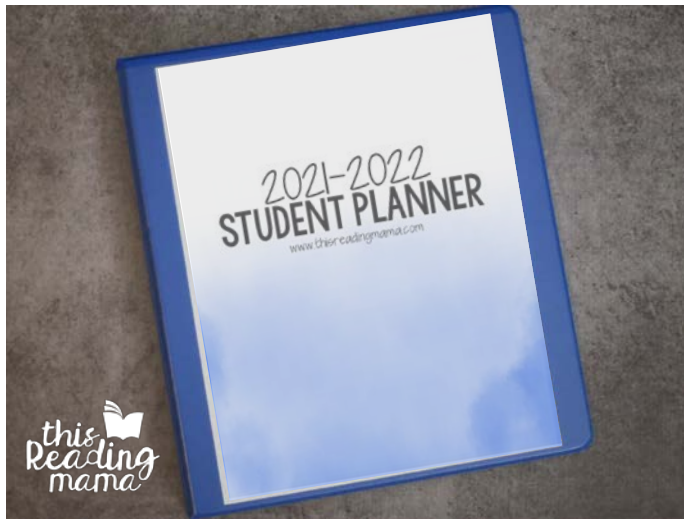
Once you open with Adobe Reader, go to "File," and select "Print." You will see a screen like the image below.

Check the box beside "Print on both sides of paper." then click "flip on long edge." {See the blue stars below.} If you do not change these settings first, your planner will not print correctly. If you want to print grayscale, click the box beside the yellow star. You can also print black/white from the black/white file.



2. Print the pages front to back from home continued...

Hole-punch your pages and put them in a 3-ring binder as seen in the images below. The nice part about using a binder is that learners can slip important papers in the pockets or use plastic sleeve protectors.



3. Just print the pages from home that you want.

If you don't want or need all the pages from the planner, only print what you want! Once you open with Adobe Reader, go to "File," and select "Print."

TWO IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT PRINTING THIS WAY:

1. If you want to print the pages front to back, be sure to follow the directions on page 5 of this file.
2. Be sure to pay attention to which pages go together so your pages look right when you print them. Extra space has been added to the inside margins of all pages so that when you hole-punch them, the holes aren't covering so much of the space you need to write in.

STUDENT PLANNER TABS

Optional: Learners can add tabs to their pages to help them quickly find what they need. I recommend printing them on cardstock, laminating, cutting them out, and taping each tab to your pages.

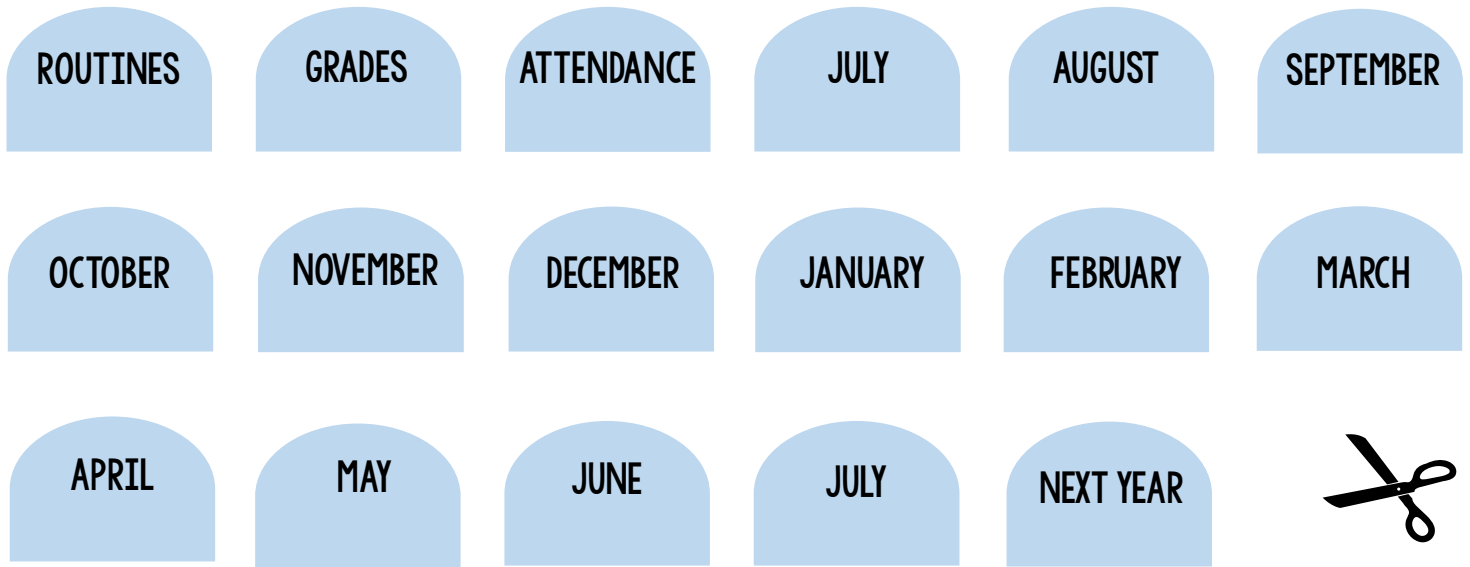
To prep your tabs, follow these steps:

- Print the tabs onto cardstock. {If you're using the blackline tabs, you can print them onto different colored paper to make them "pop."}
- Laminate tabs for durability.
- Cut out each tab.
- Tape or glue the tabs into your planner, as seen in the image below, to help learners easily locate sections of their planner.

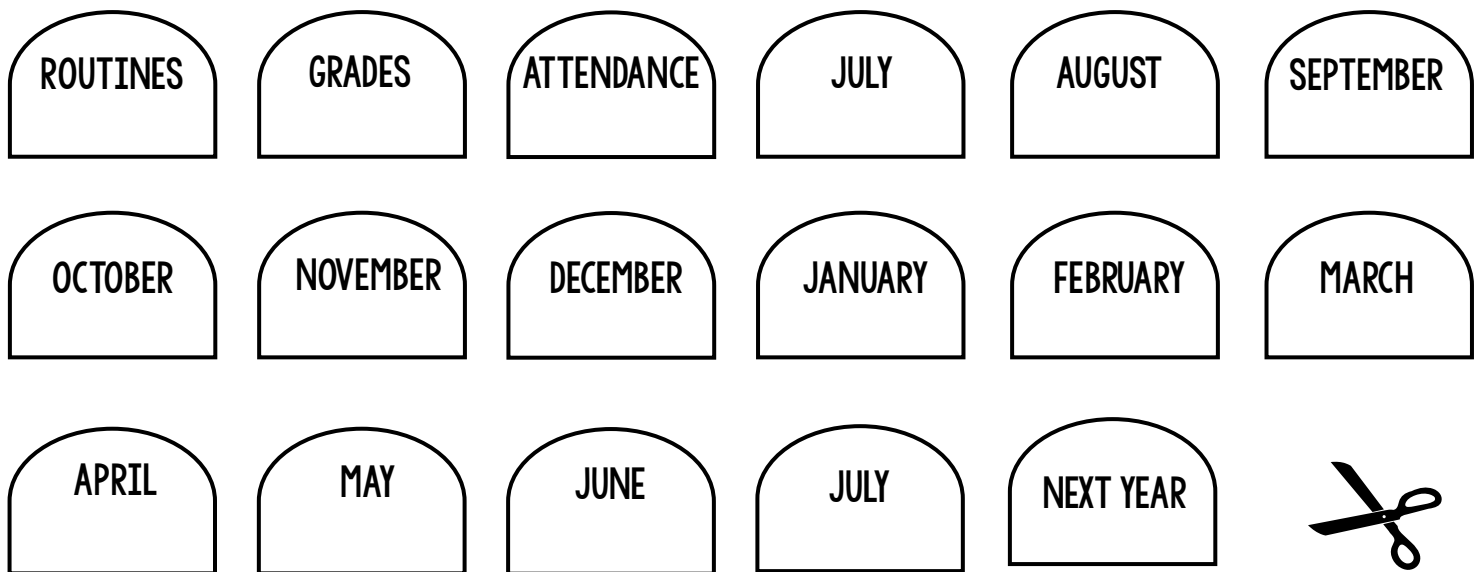
