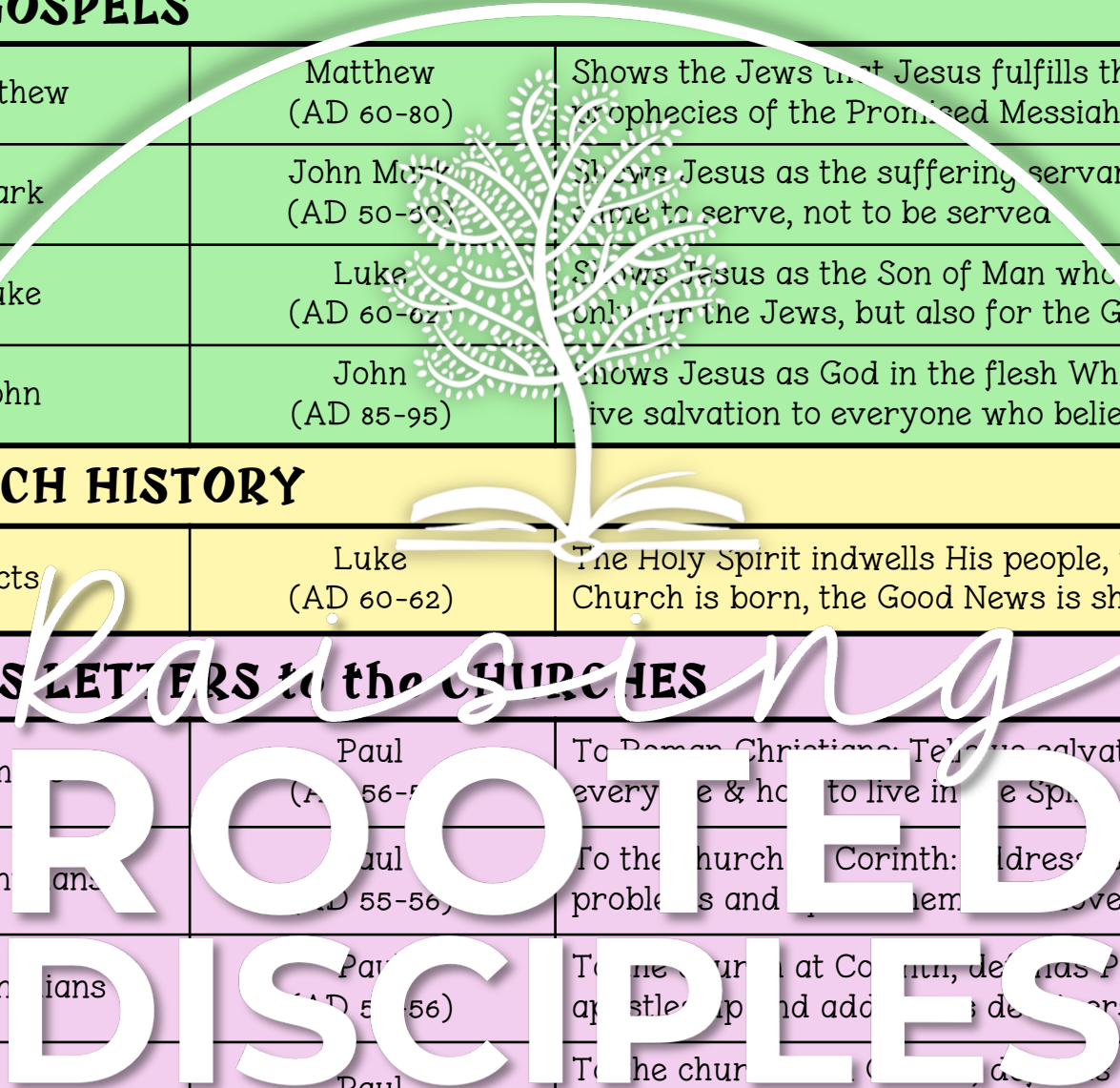

NEW TESTAMENT “Cheat” Chart

Name of Book	Author(s) & Dates Written	Main Purpose
The GOSPELS		
Matthew	Matthew (AD 60-80)	Shows the Jews that Jesus fulfills the O.T. Prophecies of the Promised Messiah
Mark	John Mark (AD 50-60)	Shows Jesus as the suffering servant Who came to serve, not to be served
Luke	Luke (AD 60-80)	Shows Jesus as the Son of Man who came not only for the Jews, but also for the Gentiles
John	John (AD 85-95)	Shows Jesus as God in the flesh Who came to give salvation to everyone who believes
CHURCH HISTORY		
Acts	Luke (AD 60-62)	The Holy Spirit indwells His people, the Church is born, the Good News is shared
PAUL'S LETTERS to the CHURCHES		
Romans	Paul (AD 56-58)	To Roman Christians: Tells us salvation is for everyone & how to live in the Spirit
1 Corinthians	Paul (AD 55-56)	To the church in Corinth: addresses problems and encourages them to love
2 Corinthians	Paul (AD 55-56)	To the church at Corinth, defends Paul's apostleship and addresses deacons
Galatians	Paul (AD 48-49 or AD 52-55)	To the church in Galatia, defends Paul's apostleship, addresses salvation through faith alone, and encourages believers to walk in Christ's freedom
Ephesians	Paul (AD 60-62)	To the church in Ephesus, addresses holy living, especially within the church & family
Philippians	Paul (AD 60-62)	To the church in Philippi, Paul expresses his affection & explains how to walk in humility
Colossians	Paul (AD 60-62)	To the church in Colossae addressing heretical teaching & shows Christ is supreme
